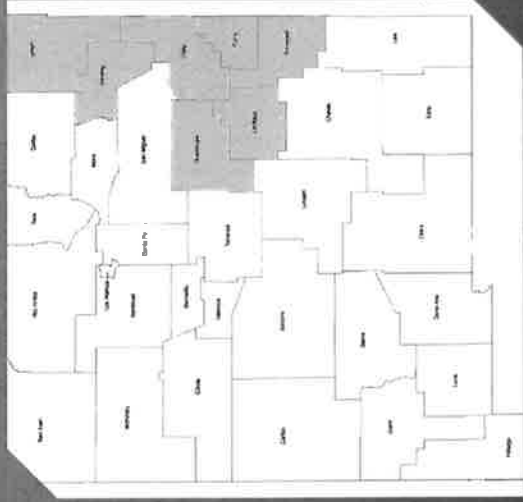

# **EPCOG BOARD REPORT**

**418 Main St**

➤ EPCOG FY23 Audit accepted and released by State Auditors office. Unmodified opinion with no findings.

➤ EPCOG has entered into fiscal agent agreements with several members for previously funded projects. We continue to charge 1% of the grant amount for fiscal agent services.

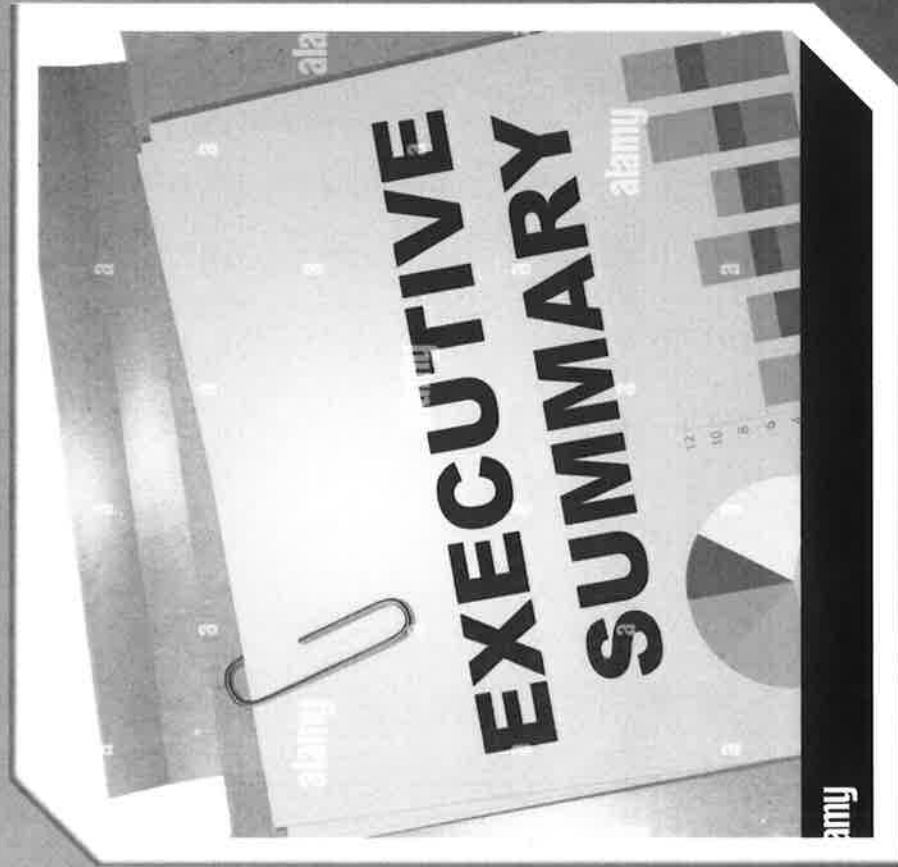
➤ Sandy is in ongoing discussions with the NM Legislative Finance Committee regarding administration of HB2.Jr funds, now called GRO funds. LFC wants to funnel these funds through the COGs and requested proposals for administrative costs. The amount of funding for each COG is still being determined.

➤ Hired Branden Goebel as Grant Specialist. Branden will be writing and administering grants. Branden wrote and submitted a grant application for the Luna Theater in Clayton.

➤ Created Rural Nursing Pipeline Program (Will Apply for Funding)

➤ HVAC improvements have begun. This is being funded by a 2023 Capital Outlay grant. Quotes being obtained for interior painting and other improvements.

➤ It was a very busy 30-day legislative session staff attended various community legislative events.



- ▶ EPCOG has obtained a contract with the village of Logan, NM to complete their comprehensive plan, staff is currently working on the plan. Vincent Soule is the lead person on that project.
- ▶ EPCOG staff continues to send out grant advisory information that we receive from the NM Congressional staff, State agencies, and other funding sources to our communities
- ▶ EPCOG continues to be involved with the NM Industrial Development Executive's Association (NMIDEA). Raymond will be serving on the NMIDEA State executive committee as past president 2024-25. Staff attended the NMIDEA Legislative Winter Meeting in Santa Fe. Awards were handed out and the business of NMIDEA was conducted along with a briefing on legislative matters.
- ▶ Raymond was finally confirmed by the NM State Senate by a Senate floor vote 33-0 to the NM Military Base Planning Commission. He will serve on the commission at the pleasure of the governor.
- ▶ EPCOG staff are working with several communities on economic development issues and potential projects. We will be assisting the City of Clovis with an application for improvements at the airport.



- ▲ EPCOG assisted several of our regional communities with legislative Capital Outlay Requests. The approved list was emailed out to the EPCOG communities.
- ▲ EPCOG is working with the New Mexico Finance Authority and the NM Mortgage Finance Authority to plan additional road show presentations in 2024 to present their financing programs.
- ▲ Continuing CDBG administration for Curry, Ft. Sumner, Vaughn and Santa Rosa.
- ▲ 2024 CDBG funds awarded to Tucumcari for improvements to their Recreation Center.
- ▲ EPCOG Staff attended numerous city and county meetings throughout the region to discuss projects and programs and offer assistance.
- ▲ Staff continues to be involved in numerous boards and committees within the city and the State.
- ▲ We continue to assist our communities in various policy and technical issues as well as grant writing and follow-up activities.

## HRSA Grant Updates

In partnership with United Way of Eastern NM, Received \$2 million from the Human Resources and Services Administration to provide counseling services in jails and schools in Curry, Roosevelt, Quay and De Baca counties for 4 years. EPCOG is the fiscal and administrative entity for this program. Celia Kirkland manages this grant.

- ▲ School Pulse has rolled out at most of the schools in our four-county region.
- ▲ There have already been interventions at two of the schools where incidents were reported on school pulse.
- ▲ Discharge collaboration meetings are taking place bimonthly.
- ▲ Taking applications for internships for the fall.
- ▲ Upcoming RCORP reverse site visit March 4-9<sup>th</sup> in Washington D.C.
- ▲ Working on Mental Health bilingual material
